

**DANIEL 7 - MATHEW 21 - MATHEW 22 - MATHEW 24
FULFILLED IN AD70**

In this first chart, we compare the major constituent elements found in both Daniel 7 and Mathew 21, demonstrating that (1) they are parallel texts, (2) the “little horn” of Daniel 7 is Old Covenant Israel, and (3) Daniel 7 was fulfilled at the time when Rome ruled the world and the Old Covenant Kingdom was taken from the ethnic nation of Israel.

In the next chart, by comparing the major constituent elements found in both Mathew 21 and 22, we demonstrate that (1) the two texts are parallel, (2) to receive the Kingdom is to partake of the wedding feast, and (3) the Old Covenant Kingdom was taken from Israel when Jerusalem was judged and burned with fire in AD70.

In this final chart, we parallel the major constituent elements found in Daniel 7, Mathew 21 and 22 with Mathew 24. By doing so, we demonstrate that (1) Mathew 24 was fulfilled in the first century generation and (2) the coming of the Son of Man on the clouds of heaven (24:30) took place at the destruction of Jerusalem and the judgement of Old Covenant Israel (the little horn) in AD70, when the kingdom of God (in its Old Covenant form) was taken from the ethnic nation of Israel and given (in its New Covenant form) to the saints of the Most High; the Church of Jesus Christ.

The second coming of Christ and the removal of the Old Covenant world in AD70 brought salvation to the righteous remnant of Israel, into whom the Gentiles (nations) were grafted at that time. Through God’s faithfulness to Israel then, we today can also receive the fullness of the promises made to the fathers; that is, eternal life in Jesus Christ.
