

## **LUKE 19 & THE SECOND COMING OF CHRIST IN AD70**

This chart convincingly demonstrates that the “coming of the Son of Man” in both Daniel 7 and Matthew 16:27-28 prophesied second coming of Christ, which was in fact fulfilled at the judgment of Jerusalem in AD70.

Fulfilled in the “last days” (2:28f - parallel prophecy) The last days existed in the first century (Acts 2:15, Hebrews 1:1-2)	Fulfilled in the lifetime of Jesus’ contemporary generation (16:28)	Fulfilled at the second coming of Christ (the return of the Nobleman from the “far country”) in AD70 (when those who had rejected his reign were slain) (19:15)

The undeniable implication of this chart is as follows:

-In fulfillment of Daniel 7, Matthew 16:27-28 prophesied the coming of the Son of Man to reward his saints with the kingdom and to bring judgment upon his enemies, in the lifetime of Jesus’ contemporary generation.

-But according to Luke 19, the coming of the Son of Man to reward his saints with the kingdom and to bring judgment upon his enemies refers to the second coming of Christ, when the Nobleman returned from the “far country” and brought destruction to his citizens who had rejected his reign.

-Therefore, the second coming of Christ was fulfilled in Jesus’ contemporary generation, when the saints were rewarded with the kingdom and the enemies of Christ were judged and destroyed. This took place at the fall of Jerusalem in AD70, when the citizens (first century Jews) who had rejected his reign were slain in his presence.
