Zechariah & Revelation: Fulfilled in the 1st Century

The following chart demonstrates that the judgment of "Babylon the great" of Revelation was the judgment of historical Old Covenant Judah and Jerusalem as prophesied in Zechariah 14, who was judged and destroyed in AD70. (The first chart is from p.165 of Don K. Preston's book, "Who Is This Babylon").

Based on the above parallels charts we conclude that the AD70 judgment of Old Covenant Judah and Jerusalem (Babylon) and their New Covenant restoration as the Church/the Body of Christ/the New Jerusalem as prophesied in Zechariah and realized Revelation, was fulfilled within the lifetime of the first century generation.
